## **VIGNOBLES MAYARD**

**Mayard, Clos du Calvaire 2009 Châteauneuf-du-Pape Red**

**Score 17.5**

**When to drink : 2015-2024**

Dark crimson. Heady nose. Hugely sweet palate entry and lots of black cherry fruit. Then it becomes a bit tauter and more refreshing on the finish. Hint of liquorice. But masses of alcohol.

**Mayard, Dom du Père Pape 2009 Châteauneuf-du-Pape**

**Score 18**

**When to drink : 2016-2025**

Very dark purple but with a clear rim. Mildly tired sample. Very sweet start and then super smooth and flattering. So long as you don't mind a bit of sweetness in your reds, you will love this. There are tannins but they are not painful. Should develop well.

**Mayard, La Crau de Ma Mère 2009 Châteauneuf-du-Pape White**

**Score 15**

**When to drink : 2009-2010**

The deepest gold of all these 2009 white Châteauneufs. Quite a bit of oak but not that much fresh fruit. It's even a bit watery. A little sickly on the finish.

**Mayard, La Crau de Ma Mère 2009 Châteauneuf-du-Pape Red**

**Score 18**

**When to drink : 2016-2026**

Slightly tired nose on this sample. Blackish purple. Very rich and ripe but with some vitality. Nice, fine tannins. Huge and bold but well done with some interest and refreshment.
